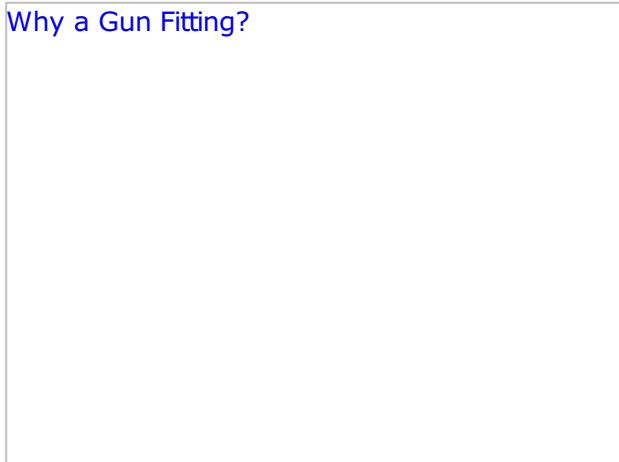

Wingshooting TIP

Gun fitting is no less critical in wingshooting than it is in clay target sports. In fact, one could argue that that you can get away with holding the gun a bit higher or even pre-mounted in clay target sports because the trajectory of the "bird" is predictable. In wing shooting however, particularly hunting over pointers, the gun must be held a bit lower giving the eyes space to see the birds rise from the ground cover. Indeed, gun fit may be more important for a field gun than a clays gun. For more information about gun fitting options, [click here](#).
